

DISCOVER THE "CITÉ DES DUCS DE SAVOIE" !

Wander through typically French "traboule" passageways with your guide, discovering squares and courtyards.

Thousands of picturesque and trompe l'oeil details are hidden behind the 19th-century façades. Listen to tales about the adventures of Général de Boigne - the famous elephant fountain was built for him, and discover the holy chapel of the castle and the history of the Dukes of Savoy.

If you go off the main roads, you will be lucky enough to discover all the secrets of Chambéry, former capital of the State of Savoy!

3. THE BOMBING OF 1944 and reconstruction



10:44 a.m. on May 26, 1944. More than 700 bombs were dropped on the city of Chambéry by two American squadrons totaling 72 B-24 Liberator aircraft. In 90 seconds, 200 people were killed, 300 wounded, and 3,000 left homeless, all victims of Operation Overlord.

But this dark chapter also shows the impressive resilience of the people of Chambéry. Commemorate the 80th anniversary of this date, which is still vivid in the collective memory, through a journey that evokes the testimonies of this suddenly darkened day and discover how the city rose from the ashes.

4. railway ROTUNDA



Construction of the Chambéry railway rotunda began in 1906. It is a great example of industrial heritage from the beginning of the 20th century, and never fails to amaze visitors!

Admire the metallic articulated Eiffel-type framework - the largest built in France!



Fully renovated, it is still in use today, and is a sign of the importance the railway played in the Savoie area in the 1850's.

Relive the major changes in railway development through the history of the rotunda, from construction to renovation, and terrible events which left their mark, such as the May 1944 bombing aiming to destroy strategic rail connections.



5. Nézin air-raid SHELTER



After decades of closure and several months of renovation, the shelter is finally open to the public...

It's 6 a.m. on May 26, 1944. In Chambéry, which is coming to life and waking up, the sirens are sounding...

On this tragic day, no less than 720 bombs weighing 227 kg each were dropped on the city by Allied bombers.

Their objective? To bomb the railway station...

Discover Chambéry's passive defense strategy, listen to accounts of the bombing or simply immerse yourself in places remarkably preserved since the Second World War.

6. the house in "LES CHARMETTES"



Located in the valley of Les Charmettes, the house where Jean-Jacques Rousseau and Madame de Warens spent their summers between 1736 and 1742 is definitely worth visiting!

It was an important place which profoundly changed the personality of the great writer of the Lumières movement. The house has retained all its character and will take you travelling back to the 18th century.

7. follow in the footsteps of JEAN-JACQUES ROUSSEAU



Wander through the maze of the typically French "traboule" passageways to the rythm of quotes from "Confessions"...and discover the mansions where Jean-Jacques Rousseau spent some of his life. And follow in the footsteps of one of the philosophers from the Lumières movement!

From the castle of the Dukes of Savoy, where he worked in the land registry office, past mansions where he gave music lessons to young girls from noble families, to the tale of his retirement to the country in Les Charmettes

Discover life in Chambéry in the 18th century through Rousseau's words.

8. SAVOIE museum

Completely renovated, the Musée Savoisien, the departmental museum of Savoie history and culture, is a unique place.

A former Franciscan convent founded in the 13th century, it boasts the only cloister with an "unobstructed view" of Savoy's heritage...



Over 2000 objects from the Palaeolithic to the present day are on display. A free journey through the geopolitical, cultural, social and economic history of Savoie and Haute-Savoie.

9. museum OF FINE ARTS



The Museum of Fine Arts of Chambéry is home to a collection of a hundred paintings, mainly Italian, from the end of the Middle Ages to the beginning of the 20th century.

Following the chronologically ordered exhibition, the visitor travels through the different movements in art history: Primitive, Renaissance, Mannerism, Baroque, Neoclassicism, discovering different genres: religious and historical, portraits and landscapes.

The Museum also hosts a program of temporary exhibitions and cultural events throughout the year.

Built in 1993 by the Paccard foundry, with 70 bells it is one of the 8 largest carillon in the world. The uniformity of the tone and an innovative mechanical system made with carbon fibre gives it a personnalit and rich sound unlike any other.

A stronghold of the Lords of Miolans from 1080 to 1539, a military masterpiece until the end of the 15th century, then a state prison of the House of Savoy until 1792, the Château de Miolans, admirably preserved with its newly restored interior garden, dominates the Combe de Savoie and offers, from the top of its old ramparts, an exceptional view from Mont-Blanc to Vercors mountains.



10. saint-christophe CAVES



Between Savoie et Dauphiné, 25 minutes from Chambéry, discover the two caves of Saint-Christophe, one underground, riddled with giant potholes, and the second, a refuge according to legend for the famous smuggler Mandrin, which can be crossed on a footbridge 20 m above ground, opening onto a panoramic view.
