ABBAYE DE HAUTECOMBE

Get to know the history of the Hautecombe Royal Abbey, a unique site in Savoie. Overlooking the Bourget Lake you'll find a haven of peace, prayer, history and architecture set in exceptional natural surroundings.

The Hautecombe Royal Abbey houses the tombs of famous Counts of Savoie, the last kings and queens of Italy, as well as around thirty princes and princesses.

An audio-guided tour of the church highlights the rich heritage of the building, visitors can admire the unusual neogothic architecture and artistic treasures.

A stronghold of the Lords of Miolans from 1080 to 1539, a military masterpiece until the end of the 15th century, then a state prison of the House of Savoy until 1792, the Château de Miolans, admirably preserved with its newly restored interior garden, dominates the Combe de Savoie and offers, from the top of its old ramparts, an exceptional view from Mont-Blanc to Vercors.

GRANDE CHARTREUSE MUSEUM & CHARTREUSE CELLARS

In the heart of the Chartreuse regional nature park, just 2 km from the famous monastery founded by Saint Bruno in 1084, come and enjoy the serenity of a former living quarters for Carthusian monks and the famous "Grand Silence".

This unique site, initiated by the monks, provides a better understanding of 900 years of history and the spirituality of the Carthusian Order.

Extend your excursion to Voiron to discover the world's longest liqueur cellar and try to unravel the secrets behind the production of many liqueurs, including the most emblematic: Chartreuse verte.

SAINT-CHRISTOPHE CAVES

Between Savoie and Dauphiné, 25 minutes from Chambéry, discover the two caves of Saint-Christophe, one underground, riddled with giant potholes, and the second, a refuge according to legend for the famous smuggler Mandrin, which can be crossed on a footbridge 20 m above ground, opening onto a panoramic view.

You can also discover the Voie Sarde, an ancient Roman road redeveloped in the 17th century.

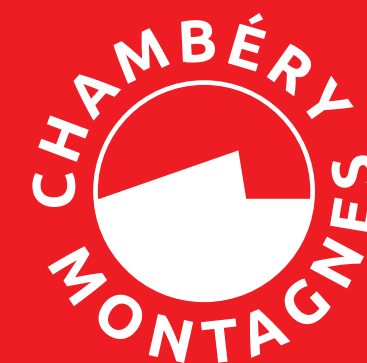
